
Ohio's Townships: Spending, Taxing & Borrowing Less Brochure Order Form



Wendell Cox, principal of Demographia, an international public policy firm, recently completed an updated version of his original 2012 report (entitled *Local Democracy in Ohio: A Review of City, Village and Township Financial Performance by Size*). The updated report, commissioned by the Ohio Township Association and the Coalition of Large Ohio Urban Townships (CLOUT), is named *Ohio's Townships: Spending, Taxing & Borrowing Less*, and it further supports the data in the 2012 report. It concludes that townships spend less, tax less and incur less debt than other local governments in the same population categories.
